

ISAIAH – Chapter 12

Vs. 1-2 Israel's response to "that day" is described – vs. 1, 4

When the nation is re-gathered and Christ is reigning, the nation will be rejoicing.

- 1) The anger of the Lord will have been turned away, vs. 1.
- 2) God will be comforting His people, vs. 1.
- 3) God will have become Israel's deliverance, vs. 2.
- 4) God will be their strength and song, vs. 2.

Vs. 3 Therefore – because of the above situation – Israel will be joyously "drawing water from the springs of God's salvation" (deliverance).

Vs. 4 In that day Israel will say:

- 1) Give thanks to the Lord.
- 2) Call on His name.
- 3) Let the world "know His deeds."
- 4) Let them remember that "His name is exalted."

Vs. 5 Praise the Lord in song:

- 1) For He has done excellent things.
- 2) Let the whole earth know it.

Vs. 6 Let the inhabitants of Israel cry aloud and shout for joy!

For God is Great and that greatness is being beheld in the midst of Israel.
