

ISAIAH – Chapter 4

Vs.2-6 The millennial kingdom.

Note: After God's original indictment (Chapter 1), He promises restoration. Isa. 2:1-4
Now at the close of the description of the judgment that is coming, Isa. 2:5-4:1,
we find another section of comfort.

In spite of the terrible judgment which faces the nation because of its sin, some will survive. The body of people being referred to is not those who will return after the Babylonian exile, but rather those who will survive the great tribulation which ends this present world order. Matt 24:4-31

Vs.2 The Branch of the Lord. Jer. 23:5, 33:14-18; Zech. 3:8-10, 6:12-13

The Branch...beautiful and glorious...fruit of the earth will be the pride and the adornment of the remnant that comes out of the tribulation.

Vs.3 The remnant that enters the millennium will be called Holy, Rom. 11:26-29 – everyone who is recorded for life.

Vs.4 It is not until this yet future time in history that God will:

- 1) Wash away the filth of...
- 2) Purge bloodshed from her midst.

By:

- 1) Spirit of judgment. Malachi 3:2-6
- 2) Spirit of fire. Matt. 3:11-12

Vs.5 In this yet future time, the glory of God will become evident in Jerusalem just as it was at the exodus. Ex. 13:21-22, 16:9-11, 40:34-38

Vs.6 God's glory, like a tent, will provide safety and peace!
