ISAIAH 58

- Vs. 1 God is calling for His "heralds" to go and get His people's attention.
- Vs. 2 A people who talk the talk, who practice their religion to be seen by all.
- Vs. 3 A people who can't believe that God is not impressed with them (they fear that God has not noticed their "act."
 - A people who separate their religious life from their everyday live a life. They had confused rituals with relationships and outward acts with inward reality.
- Vs. 4 You fast on Saturday for religious reasons and operate on a different basis the rest of the week. Deut 24:14-15; James 5:1-6
- Vs. 5-7 The following are the things that man does in hopes of receiving a positive response from God. (Maybe a positive response from people who see him?)
 - 1. A man humbles himself.
 - 2. Bows his head.
 - 3. Makes a bed with sackcloth and ashes.
 Outward acts of piety and not real "worship." Rom. 12:1-2; Isa. 1:11-17;
 James 1:22-27; 2:1-4

That which God is looking for--

If you will:

- 1. Loosens the bonds of wickedness.
- Undoes the bands of the yoke.
 Lets the oppressed go free.
 Breaks every yoke.
- 3. Divide your bread with the hungry.
- 4. Bring the homeless poor into your house. Remember Lk. 6:26-38
- 5. Cover the naked.
- 6. Don't hide yourself from your own flesh. Deut. 22:1-4

Vs. 8 Then God will cause:

- 1. Your light will break out like the dawn. (See vs. 10) Mt. 5:14
- 2. Your recovery will spring forth. Jer. 30:10-17ff
- 3. Your righteousness will go before you. (Similar to Rev. 19:7-8)
- 4. The glory of the Lord will be your rear guard. Ex. 14:19-20

Vs. 9-12

- 5. You will call and the Lord will answer. (Does God always hear?)
- 6. You will cry and He will respond in a way that you would hope for.

If you will, then He will—

If:

- 1. Remove the yoke from your midst. (Refers back to vs. 6)
- 2. Stop pointing your finger.
- 3. Speaking wickedness. (Talking trash.)
- 4. Give yourself to the hungry. Deut. 15:7-11
- 5. Satisfy the desire of the afflicted.

Then:

- 1. Your light will rise in darkness.
- 2. Your gloom will disappear.
- 3. The Lord will continually guide you. (Is it a given that the Lord guides us?)
- 4. Satisfy your desire in scorched places. (You'll find yourselves in some.)
- 5. Give strength to your bones.
- 6. You will be like a watered garden.
- 7. Like an unfailing spring of water.
- 8. You will rebuild the ancient ruins.

Raise up old foundations.

Called a repairer of the breach.

Restorer of the streets.

Vs. 13 If you will honor my Sabbath the right way for the right reasons...

Vs. 14 <u>Then</u>:

- 1. You will take delight in the Lord.
- 2. I will make you high.
- 3. I will feed you.

For the mouth of the Lord has spoken.
