- Rom 6:14 "you are not under law but under grace"
- Gal 5:18 "If you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the Law"

Example Tithing

I Old testament Principle - The Mosaic Law had three distinct tithes

Note: they were mandatory not optional

- 1. Support the Tribe of Levi 10% Hum 18:21-24 Deut 14:27
- Provision for the Festivals and Sacrifices 10% Deut 12:5-7, 10-19 Deut 14:22-26
- 3. Support of the Poor 10%/3 Deut 14:28-29

Note: Storehouse tithing

Mal 3:8-10 (Food in my house-Temple)

II. Abraham paid tithes—before The Mosaic Law

Gen 14:17-20

- 1. Abraham was not commanded-He freely gave
- 2. Abraham gave it to an individual-not a storehouse
- 3. Abraham is recorded to have tithed only once in his life
- 4. Abraham did not give a tenth of his wealth, or income; he gave a tenth of the spoils of war
- III. New testament references on tithing

Mt 23:23, Lk 11:42, Lk 18:9-12 Pharasees- under the law

Heb 7:4-10, Levi received Tithes-under the Law

IV New Testament principles of giving I Cor 16:1-2

- 1. Systematic-first day of the week
- 2. Individual-let each one of you
- 3. Privately-put aside and save
- 4. Proportionately-as he may prosper
- 5. Note: versus 3 & 4

In the Old Testament, failure to pay brought wrath and judgement

In the New Testament, failure to give liberally under grace results in loss of reward
