## CHRISTIANS IN PROPHECY

Rapture – resurrection of the bodies of believers who are part of the church.

Resurrection - 1Cor 15:35-50

Church people are raised or changed.

Jn 14:1-3; 1Cor 15:51-52; 1Thes 4:13-18; 2 Thes 2:1; Heb 9:28 Rev 4:1 with Rev 5:9-10 "reign upon the earth" (From every nation, not just Israel.)

While in heaven, during the seven year tribulation.

Bema (reward) seat of Christ (fine linen)

1Cor 3:12-15; 1Cor 9:16-17; 2Cor 5:9- 11; Rev 3:11; Rev 22:12

Followed by the marriage

Rev 19:7-8

Marriage supper follows – last 1thousand years on earth.

Rev 19:9

Christ returns to earth at the end of the tribulation.

Zech 14:1-6; Rev 19:11-19

Old Testament believers and tribulation believers are resurrected.

Dan 12:1-3; Ezk 20:33-44; Rev 20:1-6

People remaining alive, who are believers, in non-resurrected bodies will be allowed to enter the kingdom Age of 1000 years.

Matt 24:29 - 25:26

Israel Rom 11:25-29

Gentiles Matt 25:31-46

Heavenly Jerusalem will be home base for the resurrected

Heb 12:18-24

Natural (non-resurrected) people will live, and re-populate the Earth.

At the end of 1000 years Kingdom:

Present creation is burned up.

2Pet 3:7,10

New heaven, and new earth with the heavenly Jerusalem coming down out of Heaven and landing on it.

Rev 21:1 - 22:5

Believers from all ages will live with God 1Cor 15:22-28 Unbelievers from all ages will remain in the Lake of fire. Rev 20:11-15

Note: Life on earth during the thousand year Kingdom age. Isa 60:1 - 66:24; Ezk 40:1 - 48:35
