#### Chapter 1:

- = .

- 1:9 And this I pray, that "your love may abound still more and more in real knowledge and all discernment,..."
- 1:14 ... have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear.
- 1:27 29 -Only conduct yourselves in a manner "worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are "standing firm in "one spirit, with one mind "striving together for the faith of the gospel; 1:28 in no way alarmed by your opponents which is a "sign of destruction to them, but of salvation for you, and that too, from God. 1:29 -For to you "it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to "suffer for his sake.

# Chapter 2:

- 2:2 "make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose.
- 2:3 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves.
- 2:4 do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.
- 2: 5 Have this attitude in yourselves which is also in Christ Jesus. 2:6 – who, although He "existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 2:7 – but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. 2:8 – Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a

- cross. 2:9 "For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name. 2:10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth. 2:11 and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- 2:12 So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling; 2:13 for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.
- 2:14 Do all things without grumbling or disputing; 2:15 so that you will prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world, 2:16 holding fast the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I will have reason to glory because I did not run in vain nor toil in vain.
- 2:18 You too, **I urge you**, rejoice in the same way and share your joy with me.

# Chapter 3:

1 - 1

- 3:1 Finally, my brethren, "rejoice in the Lord.
- 3:2 Beware of the dogs, beware of the evil workers, beware of the false circumcision.
- 3:3 ... put no confidence in the flesh.
- 3:8 Count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ, 3:9 and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own

derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith,

3:10 – Know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death.

3:12 - Not that I have already obtained it or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus. 3:13 - Brethren, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of it yet; but one thing I do: "forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead, 3:14 - I "press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. 3:15 – Let us therefore, as many as are "perfect, have this attitude; and if in anything you have a different attitude, God will reveal that also to you. 3:16 - however, let us keep "living by that same standard to which we have attained. 3:17 - Brethren, "join in following my example, and observe those who walk according to the pattern you have in us. 3:18 - For many walk, of whom I often told you, and now tell you even weeping, that they area enemies of the cross of Christ, 3:19 - whose end is destruction, whose god is their appetite, and whose glory is in their shame, who set their minds on earthly things. 3:20 - For "our citizenship is in heaven, from which we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ; 3:21 who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

- 4:2 live in harmony in the Lord
- 4:3 help these women who have shared my struggle

- 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always
- 4:5 Let your gentle spirit be known to all men
- 4:6 Be anxious for nothing but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.
- 4:8 whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, dwell on these things.
- 4:9 The things you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, practice these things and the God of peace will be with you.

- 4:19 And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
- 4:21 Greet every saint in Christ Jesus.
